World Earth Day- Friday 25th April

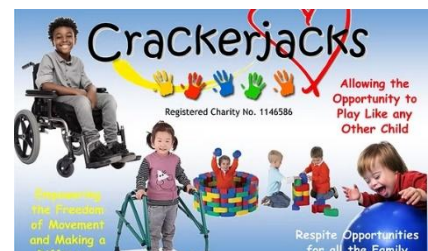
