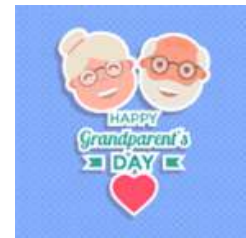

We kindly ask for a **minimum donation of £2** to help contribute to this important cause. Thank you for your continued support! Together, we can make a real difference!



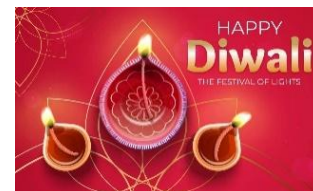
Diwali Celebration - Monday 20th October
