Monkey Puzzle proudly supports Jeans for Genes annually.

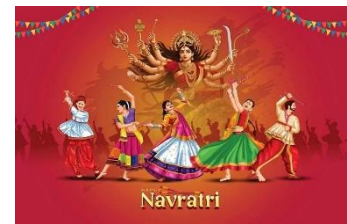
We invite all children and staff attending nursery on Tuesday to come in wearing jeans and leave a donation **of minimum £2** to help raise funds for this worthy cause.
